

Petite Sirah is our number one selling varietal wine. The deep intense fruit flavors and soft elegant tannins have become a much appreciated hallmark of the Enver Salman Vineyard Petite Sirah. We first produced a wine from this Sherman Island Vineyard in 2000, and we knew we had something special. It wasn't long for our assessment to be validated as the 2002 vintage earned 'Best Petite Sirah' designation at the California State Fair and the 2004 wine topped that with 'Best Red Wine' honors.

Enver and Joe Salman grow and deliver the finest Petite Sirah in the State of California. Their skills are even more impressive when in a difficult year, 2011, when they still manage to grow fruit that translates into a big, rich, savory wine.

The 2011 vintage has a deep purple color accompanied by bright garnet hues. The aromas feature ripe concentrated dark fruits; black currant, boysenberry and black raspberry. The bouquet is dominated by a sweet creamy oak that has nuances of caramel, milk chocolate and vanilla. On the palate, round rich flavors of red and black fruits flow into those of mocha, chocolate and oak. The texture of the 2011 vintage is rich and creamy. We have gone to great lengths to keep the tannins in check and the result is a full satisfying finish. This is a Petite Sirah with a succulent and savory aftertaste which is one of its most defining features.
