### TASTING NOTES

The 2022 '1448' has a deep dark purple color with bright youthful hues. The aromas lead with blue and black fruits, most notably boysenberry, blackberry, and dark raspberry. The bouquet features sweet caramel and vanilla scents along with those of baking spices, most notably cinnamon. The flavors are big and dense with plenty of savory concentrated ripe dark fruits framed by creamy toasted oak. The succulent fruit flavors flow into a deeply toasted oak background with a suggestion of mineral dust in the finish. Our house style is noted for mature tannins and this wine has enough to compliment a juicy steak with a peppercorn sauce, but not so much to prevent this wine from being enjoyable with a burger or pizza.

### ABOUT THE WINE

"The vineyards that provide fruit for '1448' are some of my favorites. I have always enjoyed working with Petite Sirah and Petit Verdot and I looked to these grapes to establish the framework for the 2022 wine. For some time now we have included a portion of Tannat and most recently we have included a small quantity of a Northern Italian grape; Teroldego. The color and acidity of wines made from Teroldego adds an intensity to the color and a brightness to the fruit that is welcome addition to this wine. Aged on 100% French oak, the fruit forward flavors and barrel aged texture along with rich smooth tannins remain hallmarks of this wine." - Jeff Runquist
