TASTING NOTES

The 2024 Petite Sirah displays a deep, dark purple color with impressive intensity. Aromas of ripe marionberry and briary blackberry are complemented by inviting notes of mocha, caramel, and dark chocolate from careful oak aging. The palate is rich and creamy, revealing layers of black currant, dark berry fruit, and well-seasoned oak supported by beautifully integrated tannins. Rather than overpowering, the tannins contribute a smooth, mouth-coating texture that adds depth and richness without excessive astringency. Bright acidity provides balance, carrying the wine through an exceptionally long, lingering finish and ensuring both immediate enjoyment and excellent cellar potential.

ABOUT THE WINE

Petite Sirah has long been prized for its intense color, rich black fruit, and bold structure, traditionally serving as a blending grape to add depth and character to red wines. At Jeff Runquist Wines, we take a different approach. Sourced from Clarksburg, where the warm climate naturally produces a softer expression of the variety, and crafted with gentle winemaking techniques to preserve ripe, supple tannins, our Petite Sirah delivers all the richness and concentration the grape is known for while remaining balanced, approachable, and unmistakably Runquist.
