TASTING NOTES

The 2024 1448 Red Table Blend displays a deep, inky purple color with bright youthful hues. Aromas of ripe blackberry, blueberry, plum, and cassis are complemented by rich notes of caramel, mocha, and butterscotch from French oak aging. The palate is savory and succulent, with layers of dark red and black fruit supported by creamy oak and soft, integrated tannins. The finish is long, smooth, and balanced, making this an approachable yet remarkably expressive red blend.

ABOUT THE WINE

1448 is our signature red table blend, created as an introduction to the Runquist House Style. Named after the elevation of our Amador County winery, it reflects Jeff's long-standing appreciation for bold red varieties traditionally used to add color, structure, and depth to California wines. Built primarily around Petite Sirah, Petit Verdot, Tannat, and Teroldego, the blend showcases ripe fruit, rich texture, and polished tannins. While the composition evolves slightly with each vintage, 1448 consistently delivers a full-flavored, fruit-forward wine that offers exceptional character and outstanding value.
